

Doctor Care Anywhere (DOC: \$A1.47)

Doctor Care Anywhere jumps 7.7% Wednesday January 13, 2021 16:00 AEST

Doctor Care Anywhere Group PLC (ASX:DOC), Australia's 21st largest Health care company by market cap, has jumped 10.50c (7.7%) from its previous trading session to close at \$A1.47. Compared with the All Ordinaries Index which rose 14.8 points (0.2%) in the day, the relative price increase was 7.5%.

There were 623,965 shares worth \$A917,229 traded today. The volume was 0.3 times the average daily trading volume of 2.4 million shares.

The stock was listed on Dec 4 and the last price represents a premium of 83.8% to the issue price of 80c.

Today's Volatility:

- Doctor Care Anywhere (DOC:\$A1.47) rises 7.7% on increasing volatility: Since the start of trading its volatility (highest price minus lowest price/lowest price) of 11.8% equalled the average daily volatility of 11.8%, up from 8.1% on Tuesday and 8.6% on Monday.

Past Week:

- Doctor Care Anywhere is placed 163/1639 in BuySellSignals' ranking of Australian performers in the past week, a percentile ranking of 90.
 - In the past week, volume was 0.4 times average and the shares were up 12.2%. Wednesday's close price is at a 3.5% premium to its 5-day Volume Weighted Average Price (VWAP) of \$A1.42.
 - The stock posted rises of more than 7.6% on 2 out of 5 days in the past week of trading. The top rise was 8.8%.

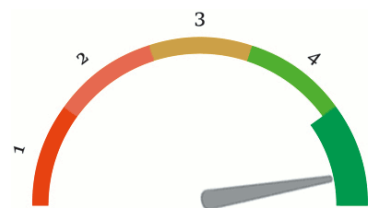
Fig 5: High Price Performance Indicators and rank of Doctor Care Anywhere in the Australian market:

- The current short volume is 0.7 times its own historical average of 0.02%. It plummeted 38.4% from the previous day, a bullish indicator.
